## SUPPLIES NEEDED:

1- REUSABLE WATER BOTTLE LABELED WITH CHILD'S NAME
1- Pair of headphones (labeled with Child's name) *Having an extra pair on standby is always a good idea
1- Mouse (wireless or corded) *This is not required, but many of our students find them helpful
20+ Plain number 2 Pencils (Pencils with designs and plastic wrappings do not sharpen properly)
1-16-24 pack crayons or colored pencils
1-Spiral Bound Notebook
1- Pair of scissors
1-Glue stick
1 - Pack of general purpose copy paper


1 - One and a Half Inch Three ring binder
1-Bottle of Clorox Wipes
1 - Pack write-on tabbed dividers (Please label them Morning Work, Math, Science/SS, Reading, Language)
1- LARGE Zippered three ring pencil pouch (to hold Crayons, markers, pencils, scissors, and glue)
*** Please do not bring rolling book bags or plastic pencil boxes. Rolling book bags are difficult to maneuver in the hallways with so many students transitioning. Plastic pencil boxes are notorious for falling, breaking, and being very noisy and messy in class and when transitioning. Zippered pencil pouches that can be kept within the binder are the best choice and are required this year.
