Directions:

1. Follow the prompt below.
2. Your One Pager should be presented using a poster white paper (one side only).
3. Focus on (1) one theme from the narrative that relates to a form of freedom OR bondage in the narrative.

### **The One Pager**

- The one pager is a single page response that shows your understanding of *The Narrative of the Life of Frederick Douglas, An American Slave*. It is a way of presenting your individual, unique understanding. It is a way to be creative and experimental. It is a way to respond to your reading imaginatively and honestly while being brief and compressed.

**Directions for your One Pager:** Check each off task as it is completed

\_\_\_\_\_ **Title with Author:** Put the title and author located somewhere the reader will notice it. Make sure that your title is creative and original.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Theme:** Pick ONE theme from the narrative and explain how it relates to a form of freedom OR bondage in the narrative. Support your thoughts with references from the text.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Personal Response:** Make a personal statement about the theme by explaining what the theme means to you.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Quotes or Excerpts:** Find TWO notable quotes or excerpts from the text that demonstrates ONE of the themes of the narrative. Explain what the quotes mean and how you relate to the theme. Include appropriate citations from the text.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Visual images:** Use insightful visual images (drawn, cut from magazines, computer, etc). These pictures need to illustrate what pictures you have in your mind from reading. Feel free to use markers to make it colorful.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Question:** Ask one question about the theme and thoroughly answer it by citing evidence from the text.

### **How to Make your One Pager Successful**

- Give your audience insight into your thinking and processing of reading
- Follow ALL of the directions
- Do not merely summarize
- Use colored pens or markers to make your work more visually appealing
- Fill the entire page and be creative

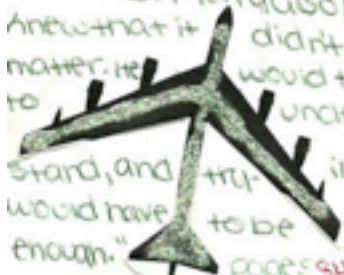
