

# Wallace Campbell Minority Book Scholarship

The Wallace Campbell Minority Book Scholarship seeks to identify graduating seniors from Thomas County Central High School who aspire to continue their education at an accredited four-year university. In addition, applicants must excel academically, exhibit leadership potential, and demonstrate active participation within the local community.

The purpose of the scholarship is to facilitate and encourage minority students to further their education by assisting students with meeting the challenges and financial burdens of entering into college.

## ***Criteria:***

1. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
2. Applicant must provide proof of acceptance/registration to an accredited four-year university.
3. Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.

## ***Application Process:***

1. Applicants must submit a completed application to the Guidance Office by March 25, 2020. The application must be completed in full. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
2. To ensure fairness in the selection of scholarship recipients, a diverse committee is selected to carefully review and evaluate each completed scholarship application.
3. Upon selection, the scholarship recipient will be notified in writing by mail. The scholarship award will be presented to the recipient on Graduation Day Ceremony.
