Science Project Display Board

Now that you have wrapped up your project, it is time to show what you learned by completing your display board. Your project display needs to be on a tri-fold board that can be purchased from the school for \$3.00 or from a store that sells school supplies. The board needs to be done neatly, and the font needs to be large enough to easily be read when standing in front of your presentation. All sections need to be labeled. Make it colorful and attractive, so that it will attract the judges' attention. Remember, these will be displayed in the school library. Make sure your work represents your best efforts, and is something we can be proud to display.

The following is a list of components I will be looking for when grading science project backboards.

- 1) Title: this needs to be large and in the center of the board
- 2) Purpose
- 3) Question
- 4) Hypothesis
- 5) Variables
- 6) Materials and Procedure
- 7) Pictures of you conducting your experiment
- 8) Graph of your results
- 9) Conclusion
- 10) Acknowledgements

Remember, all of this information is already typed for your research report, so all you have to do is play with the font size so that it is readable. It is also a good idea to matt everything. This makes your backboard more appealing. Neatness, spelling, and grammar will also be factors in the grade of the backboard.
