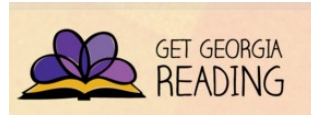


Accessing eBooks this Summer

Get Georgia Reading is providing free access to 63,588 eBooks this summer.

To login, go to myON.com and click the red Log in now button.

Note: Do not cut and paste. Start typing "Get Georgia" and select the school from the drop down menu when it appears.

2022 Summer Reading Challenge



Each student that meets the requirements of the challenge will be treated to:

Your challenge is to
read 8 books this summer

The books can be fiction chapter books or nonfiction books—(for longer books, each 100 pages you read count as 1 book)

Books should be appropriately challenging for you. (In other words, don't pick a book you read in third grade.)

Make an attempt to find books in your Lexile range!

Your book selections should not be 100% fiction or nonfiction. For example, you could read 4 nonfiction, 2 fiction, & 2 graphic novels, or 6 fiction and 2 nonfiction books.

Your nonfiction selections could be biographies.



What you must turn in:

- *The title and author of each book
- *The type of book (fiction or nonfiction)
- *Where you found each book (for example: eBook, at home, TCMS eBook, the public library, a bookstore)
- *Have fun with this part, write a 6-8 sentence response to what you've read. It could be a summary that explains your feelings towards the book, an alternate ending, your favorite character and why, your favorite part of the book and why, BE CREATIVE and HAVE FUN!

An example:

Title and author: Counting by 7's by Holly Goldberg Sloan

Type: Fiction

Where I found the book: eBook on Destiny Read

Paragraph: The book *Counting by 7's* is about a girl named Willow Chance who has to find a new family after her adopted parents die in a car crash. Willow is not your average girl. She is different and strange, so fitting in is always hard for her. Even though things are tough for Willow, she learns that family is important and all families are not the same. I liked this book because it is funny and sad all at the same time. My favorite character was Willow's guidance counselor named Dell. The things they discover at his house really made me laugh!

You can either type or write your responses. They are due to Mrs. Craven in the media center no later than 3:30 PM on Friday, August 12, 2022. (This is the first Friday of the school year).
