## **Service Learning**

What is service learning, and why is it important?

Service Learning connects meaningful service experiences with academic learning, personal growth, and civic responsibility. Service learning extends student learning beyond the classroom and provides structured time for students to reflect on their experiences. Students learn to research community needs, develop and organize solutions, and to use interpersonal communication skills and problem-solving strategies.

- ➡ Example of a Service Learning experience Students receive training at the Humane Society and learn to work with the dogs and cats so that they are more adoptable. This experience earns service learning hours.
- **⇒** Example of a Community Service project that is NOT service learning Students pack food bags for children who may not have sufficient food for the weekends. This valuable activity earns <u>community service</u> hours.
- **⇒** Service Learning can be a valuable addition to a college or scholarship application as it demonstrates growth and community engagement.
- ➡ Remember Service Learning hours and Community Service hours should be submitted ASAP after they are performed, and definitely by the end of the 9 week period in which they were undertaken. The online submission form is
