## **All About Advanced Placement**

Everything you need to know and more about AP Classes!

- ★AP CLASSROOM all students in AP classes use this to practice answering AP-style questions online; the rationale for correct answers is provided and a progress dashboard helps students pinpoint strong and weak content areas to help them prepare for the AP Exams.
- ★AP EXAM REGISTRATION students must either sign up for their exams (or decline) on their AP Classroom portal by Oct. 21.
- ★AP EXAM COST a full-price AP Exam is \$94. Thomas County Schools will subsidize the cost of AP exams for students earning qualifying grades and who meet an attendance requirement:
- A fee of **\$20 per exam** is due by Nov. 4; cash or check/money order payable to TCCHS; give to Mrs. Dixon (front office) or Mrs. White (MERIT office.)
- If a student earns an 85 or higher unweighted course average at the end of 1st Semester and has 5 or fewer absences in the AP class by the date of the exam, the school district will pay the remaining \$74 for the exam.
- If a student earns an 80-84 unweighted course average at the end of 1st Semester and has 5 or fewer absences in the AP class by the date of the exam, the school district will pay **half** of the remaining cost of the exam and the student will pay the balance of \$37.
- The balance of one STEM exam per student is paid for by the GA DOE.
- Fee waivers are available for students who qualify; see Dr. Rehberg.
- College Board's exam cancellation fee is \$40 for each cancelled exam.
- College Board's late registration fee is \$40 for each exams ordered late.

## Why Should A Student Take the AP Exam?

AP is a global credential - recognized worldwide!

- ★AP EXAM SCORES do not affect the grade a student earns in the class, but qualifying scores will help a student earn credit for college and signal to universities that a student is ready to learn on the collegiate level.
- ★RESEARCH shows that students who take AP courses and exams are much more likely than to complete a college degree on time than those who do not.
- ★COLLEGE BOARD AP SCHOLAR AWARDS can be earned by taking and excelling on tests. These distinctions can factor into college admissions.
