What's new for TCCHS MERIT in 2019-2020?

It's a great time to be an advanced learner in Thomas County!

- ★Advanced Placement options are expanding, with more opportunities for 9th and 10th grade students to take AP and more courses being added.
- ★AP Capstone will be available for students entering 9th grade in Fall 2019.
- ★New Merit faculty are here! Please welcome Mrs. Burnette and Mrs. White to TCCHS. A familiar TCMS face, Mrs. Rogers, will be on campus as well.
- ★The AP Focus classes are offered this year to AP students who need structured study time and personalized guidance in completing their AP assignments for other courses and for AP/SAT/ACT test preparation.
- ★Thomas County Schools will subsidize the cost of AP exams for students earning qualifying grades and who meet an attendance requirement.

Important changes in Advanced Placement!

Beginning in August, new digital tools will give AP students personalized feedback; exam sign-ups will be in October.

- ★Students will be able to practice answering AP-style questions online with the rationale for correct answers provided.
- ★A progress dashboard will help students pinpoint strong and weak content areas to assist with test preparation.
