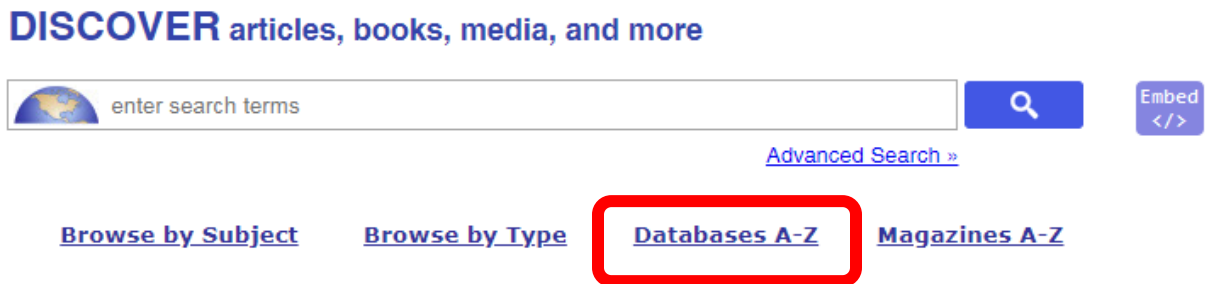


Directions for getting to the special “National History Day” section on GALILEO

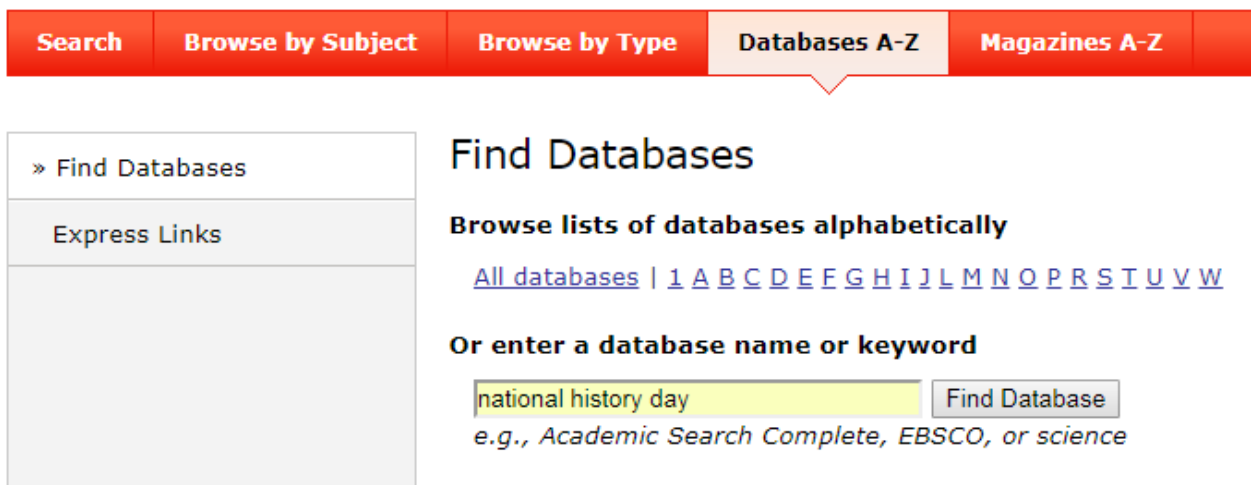
- 1) Make sure you are logged in and you’re in the high school section, if you are given the choice.
