

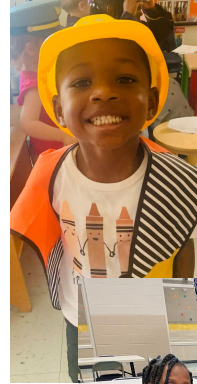

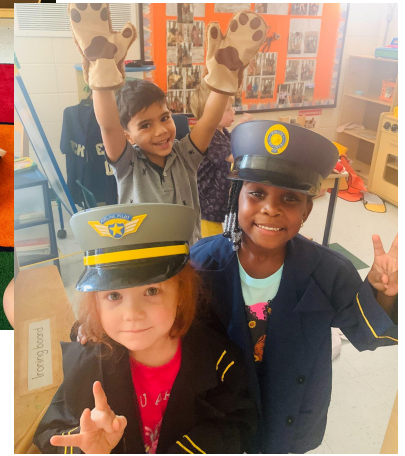

 try this . . . Learn and Laugh Together

Number Stories: Place four pennies in a row and say: "Peter had four pennies." Take one penny away and say, "One penny rolled away. How many pennies are left?" Continue with other number stories, such as: "Peter has two pennies." (Put down two pennies.) "He found one more." (Put down one penny.) "How many pennies does he have?" You can also have your child use the pennies to make up a number story for you to solve.
