

BISHOP HALL DRESS CODE
2013-2014

Any violation of the Dress Code will result in Saturday School

1. **Students must be dressed properly at the time they arrive on campus, and remain that way until they leave the campus**
2. **Khakis, shorts, skirts**
 - must have belt loops
 - colors must be solid color khaki (tan), black, olive or grey
 - appropriate length shorts
 - no cargo pants or shorts
 - no excessive decorative thread allowed
 - pants/shorts must fit at waist and not sag (If you are sitting on your belt, they are too low).
 - must be hemmed
 - no cut-offs or rolled-up cuffs permitted
 - no frayed or cut pants, skirt or shorts
 - no overalls
 - no pants with drawstrings
 - no sweatpants
 - Corduroys are acceptable
3. **Capris (worn by females only)**
 - tan, black or olive capris only (solid color)
 - no denim
 - no excessively faded capris
 - must have belt loops
4. **Jeans**
 - tan, black, gray or olive jeans only (solid color)
 - no excessively faded jeans
 - must have belt loops
5. **Shirts, sweaters, vests, slip-over-the-head jackets**
 - no logos except Bishop Hall logos
 - colors must be dark green, white, black or grey – solid colors, no mixing of colors
 - shirts must be Polo-type shirts with buttons or oxford-style shirts with button-down collars.
 - sweaters must be solid Bishop Hall colors (black, grey, white, green)
 - turtle-neck sweaters and mock turtle-neck sweaters must be Bishop Hall colors
 - shirts must be tucked in at all times – exception is made for pregnant girls who are showing
 - no thermal undershirts are to be worn under the short sleeve dress code shirt. Solid, school-color (white, black, hunter green, grey), short-sleeve undershirts with no writing are allowed under the dress code shirt.
6. **Sweatshirts – only Bishop Hall colors are allowed with no logos**
7. **T-shirts**
 - only Bishop Hall t-shirts are allowed
 - specialty t-shirts (blood drive, Peace Jam, Habitat, school field trip shirt etc.) can be worn on Friday only.
8. **Belts**
 - must be worn at all times
9. **Shoes**
 - no bedroom slippers
10. **Headgear**
 - caps, hats, scarves and headbands not to be worn in building
 - no combs worn in hair
11. **Accessories**
 - not to be excessive or gang related
