Your challenge: Read 8 books this summer

The books can be fiction chapter books or nonfiction books.

The title and author of each book

The type of book (fiction or nonfiction)

Where you found each book (for example: at home,

TCCHs eBook, the public library, a bookstore)

A 6-8 sentence paragraph that summarizes each book
and explains your feelings towards the book

Title and author: Six of Crows by Leigh Bardugo

Type: Fiction

Where I found the book: TCCHS ebook

Paragraph: THIS WAS SO GREAT! I absolutely love the world building--there's a cool magic system and lots of different cities/cultures that have really fascinating dynamics. The ensemble cast of characters is also fantastic! They all have interesting backstories and distinct personalities. Writing is great, story is awesome, pacing on point. It wasn't quite PERFECT, but it was pretty freaking close, and I can't wait for the sequel!
