### **B. REACH Georgia**

Dr. Kornegay informed the board that Gov. Nathan Deal issued accommodation to the school system for participating in the REACH GA program which is for low income and academically promising students. He said that Thomas County Middle School has five students that have been selected for REACH scholarships that are worth \$10,000 each. Students are selected as 8th graders and they have sort of an agreement that if they maintain a certain grade point average, stay out of trouble and meet certain milestones throughout their high school career, they're guaranteed scholarships when they graduate. The scholarship can be used at either technical college or a four year college or university. Local businesses sponsor \$1,500 of the scholarship and the balance of it is paid by the state.
