Mr. Holland opened the budget hearing with a power point presentation of the FY20 budget. He said there is a slight increase in the projection of local taxes and for the second year in a row, there is a 1.2 million dollar increase in equalization. There is a \$3,000 increase in teachers' salaries and a 3% increase in salaries of non-certified employees with the state providing money for the salary increases. Overall, the increase in revenue for the budget is 5.1%.
